



Our 41-credit Diploma is a one-year hybrid program with a fall start that prepares nurses to provide bedside care and interact closely with patients. Graduates are eligible to apply for licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

The hybrid delivery model consists of online courses and in-person meetings. Course work online is asynchronous, it can be completed any time of day or night- whenever your schedule allows. Labs and clinicals take place on campus and in-person at either NTC or one of our local clinical sites. Students can plan to be in-person for approximately 3-4 consecutive days twice per month for the duration of the program, approximately 21 days per semester.

Our programs are accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN). All Nursing programs have separate applications and admission criteria/ prerequisites; acceptance to NTC is not an acceptance to the PN program. You must be accepted into the Practical Nursing program to enroll in PNSG courses.
