



Our 41-credit Diploma is a one-year program with a fall start that prepares nurses to provide bedside care and interact closely with patients. Graduates are eligible to apply for licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

The hybrid delivery model consists of online courses and in-person meetings. Course work online is asynchronous. It can be completed any time of day or night- whenever your schedule allows. Labs and clinicals take place on campus and in-person at either NTC or one of our local clinical sites. **Students can plan to be in person for 21 days per semester.**

A Certified Nursing Assistant active within 5 years or HLTH 1110: Nursing Assistant
TEAS score of 53 or higher within 2 years
Active Basic Life Support or HLTH 1410: First Aid/CPR or equivalent

Once the above requirements have been met, students can fill out the online Practical Nursing Application. Nursing applications are separate from the NTC institutional application. Students will learn of their admission status to the program approximately 30 days after the application has been submitted. Accepted students must accept their seat within two weeks of receiving their acceptance letter via email. Northwest Technical College utilizes rolling admissions. We review program applications in the order they are received until program seats and wait lists are full. Completion of prerequisites does not guarantee admission to our nursing programs.





After completion of prerequisites, students who are pursuing the Practical Nursing program can take the general courses listed below if they are planning to pursue our LPN Step-In Program. Our LPN Step-In program has its own set of prerequisite courses. Taking courses will prepare you for the LPN Step-In application after the PN program is completed. Taking these general courses will not accelerate the PN or LPN Step-In programs; it will only lighten a students total credit load once in the program.
